Product Description

AquaSticker is a light tan powder made up of specialized bacteria, catalysts, and micronutrients designed to upset the normal balance in the microbiota microbial populations.

Uses and Applications

AquaSticker is used as a sticking agent for algaecides in treating algae as well as other cyanobacteria that form benthic mats. AquaSticker sticks to algae and temporarily relaxes the microbiota. When used with algaecides, AquaSticker allows applicators to reduce copper in their treatments, saving them money and creating a more natural treatment without sacrificing results.

Dose Rates when combined with a granular, peroxide, or copper algaecide:

Use 20# per acre first application, 10# per acre second application and 5# per acre maintenance dose. Can be added directly as a dry product or as a liquid sprayed over water.

Dose rates when used as an adjuvant with copper:

Add 1# per 189 litres tank mix. This product should be evenly distributed for best results.

Ingredients

Bio-vitamins, probiotics, and micronutrients.

Storage and Handling

Store in a cool, dry space between 10-25 degrees C. Keep out of direct sunlight and do not store with strong oxidizing agents.

Safety + First Aid

When handling, wear personal protection equipment. This product is considered non-toxic, if concerned consult a physician. In case of skin contact, wash exposed area with soap and water. In case of eye contact, immediately rinse eyes with plenty of water.
